Narrative:

On Monday, February 9, 2015, at approximately 09:30am, the Kent County Sheriff Department began investigating a missing person complaint. 26 year old Anthony Baker left his apartment in Plainfield Township on Sunday, 2/8/2015, around 1:30PM, and has not been seen since. He was last seen walking in the 2600 block of Northvale Drive.

It is believed that Anthony may be lost and confused due to medical condition. He is described as a white male, 6'1", 180 lbs, dirty blonde Mohawk and brown eyes. He was last seen wearing black pants, brown boots, electric blue and black stripped hoodie and a grey beanie hat with a dragon.
