The Kent County Sheriff Department and several other West Michigan Law Enforcement agencies are currently investigating a rash of credit card fraud complaints. It is believed at this time that the suspects are using a skimming device to obtain credit card information from unknowing victims.

Investigators have identified possible suspects as being Inoveidis Giron-Ferro, age 34, and Edrey Santo-Rojas, age 29, who are residents of Florida. Giron-Ferro is shown wearing a Detroit Tigers ball cap and Santo-Rojas is shown wearing Chevrolet ball cap. The suspects have been using the credit card information to make purchases and police are looking for assistance with locating them. The suspects are driving a silver over blue 2000 Ford Excursion with Florida registration D1BFP.
