On March 1, 2015, the Kent County Sheriff Department was contacted by the family of Teresa Lynn Curry, w/f, 44 years. The family reported Teresa missing from her Comstock Park, Alpine Township home and she was last seen on Friday, February 27, 2015. Teresa Curry is further described as 5'2, 120 pounds, short brown hair, last seen wearing a pink coat, jeans or khaki pants, black knit hat and blue tennis shoes.

Teresa was last known to be at the Speedway Gas Station at 4100 West River Dr Ne at 0800 hours on Friday, February 27, using the ATM. She was also reported to have quit her job at Kohl's Department store in Grandville two weeks prior.

The family is concerned for her well-being. They indicate that is out of character for her not have contact with family. Teresa is described as being near deaf requiring hearing aids in both ears. At this time there is no other medical conditions known to investigators.

We request the public assistance in locating Teresa Curry.

UPDATE: MISSING PERSON LOCATED – JULY 7, 2015

On Monday, July 7, 2015, the Kent County Sheriff Department made contact with Teresa Curry. Teresa indicated she left the State of Michigan and travelled to State of New York and stayed in New York City. She just recently returned home and has been reunited with family. No foul play is involved as Teresa left voluntarily.
