On Wednesday, October 21, 2015, the following law enforcement agencies in Kent County along with several law enforcement agencies nationwide participated in the 13th Annual National Family Violence Apprehension Detail—Also known as the "Domestic Violence Warrant Sweep":

The SWEEP is a day-long event, in which agencies across the United States attempt to serve outstanding family-violence warrants.

This is the first year law enforcement agencies in Michigan have participated in this event. Our local SWEEP detail had 55 members from the above agencies attempt to serve 109 warrants which resulted in the arrest of 16 offenders.
