On Friday, October 30, 2015 at approximately 7:45 am, the Kent County Sheriff's Department, Byron Township Fire Department, Georgetown Township Fire Department and AMR ambulance responded to a report of a multiple car, serious injury accident on eastbound M6 near Wilson Ave.

Upon deputies arriving on scene, they determined a 2006 Subaru Outback, driven by 18 year old Khang-Kenneth Vo was travelling westbound on M6 when the Subaru crossed over the median and struck a 2011 Ford F250 Super Duty pickup driven by 36 year old Kevin Vardon who was travelling eastbound on M6.

The initial collision between the two vehicles caused several other minor property damage accidents at the same location, causing a short closure of M6 while the accidents were investigated and the vehicles involved were removed from the scene.

The driver of the at-fault vehicle Khang-Kenneth Vo suffered life threatening injuries and was transported by AMR ambulance to an area hospital. The non at-fault driver and passenger suffered minor injuries and were also transported to an area hospital by AMR for further treatment.

The sheriff's department's investigation is ongoing at this time and it's unknown why the at-fault vehicle had crossed the median. Anyone with information about the accident is asked to call the Kent County Sheriff's Department at (616) 632-6237.
