

**AMENDED PETITION FOR MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT PURSUANT TO
CHAPTER 20 OF ACT 40 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF MICHIGAN, 1956, AS
AMENDED**

KNAPP'S CORNER DRAIN

TO THE KENT COUNTY DRAIN COMMISSIONER:

The undersigned public corporations in the State of Michigan, namely the City of Grand Rapids and the Charter Township of Grand Rapids, hereby amend the petition signed on behalf of the City of Grand Rapids on January 10, 2023 and on behalf of the Charter Township of Grand Rapids on January 11, 2023 and January 16, 2023 (the "Original Petition") and hereby petition to make improvements to and extend the Knapp's Corner Drain, including, but not limited to improvements to and expansion of the detention pond and the construction of a positive drainage outlet which may include a gravity storm sewer, pump station and force main, or combination thereof, which shall run from the detention pond to the Grand River (the "Drain Project"), wholly located and established in the City of Grand Rapids and the Charter Township of Grand Rapids in the County of Kent, State of Michigan, as provided in Chapter 20 of the of Act 40 of the Public Acts of Michigan, 1956, as amended, (the "Drain Code"). The Drain Project includes additions to the route and course of the drain that are anticipated to proceed along Dunnigan Avenue from the detention pond to Three Mile Road and down Three Mile Road to the Grand River or such other route and course as may be determined by the Knapp's Corner Drain Drainage District.

The Drain Project is necessary for the public health.

This amendment to the Original Petition is filed pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Drain Code.

It is understood that the cost of the Drain Project is to be wholly assessed against public corporations, including these petitioners.

A certified copy of the Resolution of the governing body of the City of Grand Rapids and the Charter Township of Grand Rapids authorizing the execution of this amendment to the Original Petition is hereby attached.

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



1. The City of Grand Rapids, Michigan, is a Michigan municipal entity (the "City"); and
2. The City acting by and through its legislative body, the City Commission, recognizes that it is necessary and conducive for the public health to make improvements to and extend the Knapp's Corner Drain, including, but not limited to improvements to and expansion of the detention pond and the construction of a positive drainage outlet which may include a gravity storm sewer, pump station and force main, or combination thereof, which shall run from the detention pond to the Grand River (the "Drain Project"), pursuant to Chapter 20 of Public Act 40 of Michigan, 1956, as amended (the "Drain Code"); and
3. A portion of the lands to be benefited by the Drain Project are located within the City; and
4. The City recognizes that it will be subject to assessment to pay for a percentage of the cost of the Drain Project; therefore

RESOLVED:

1. That the City Commission authorizes and approves the filing of an amended petition for the Drain Project in substantially the form of the attached exhibit; and
2. That the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the amended petition in substantially the form of the attached exhibit and to approve such changes in, and modifications to, the Petition consistent with this Resolution that do not materially adversely affect the City and as approved by the City Engineer and the City Attorney; and
3. That the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the cost sharing agreement and to approve such changes in, and modifications to, the Petition consistent with this Resolution that do not materially adversely affect the City and as approved by the City Engineer and the City Attorney; and

4. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby rescinded.
