Dear Property Owner,

You have received this notice because you own property within the Drainage District of the Winslow Drain. The Winslow Drain is an open channel that serves properties by collecting storm water runoff from properties and roads within the drainage district.

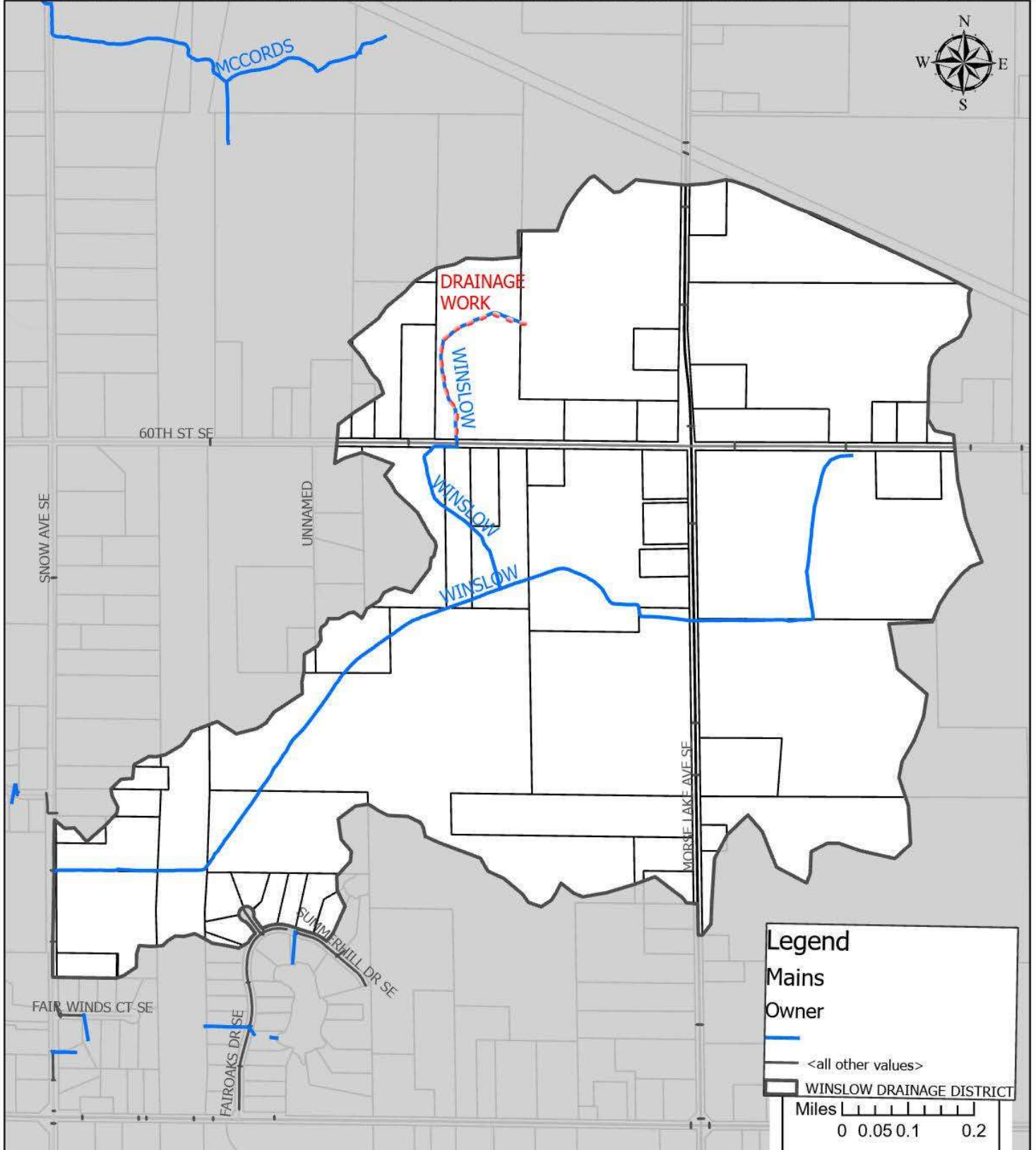
The Drain Commission recently completed drainage work in the Spring of this year on the channel north of 60th Ave. The cost of the maintenance will be placed on the Drainage District for a 2-year annual assessment. There are no changes to your apportionment percentage cost. Costs for maintenance are not provided by other means such as regular property taxes; we must assess the costs for maintenance to the property owners and governmental units within the District. The Special Assessment will be placed on your Winter Tax Bill starting in 2024 and will be spread for 2-years.
