On March 4, 2016, the Kent County Sheriff Department responded to the Tanger Outlet Mall on the report of a subject eavesdropping in one of the stores.

The victim in the incident was trying on clothes in a changing room that did not have a ceiling over it. As she was changing her clothes, she noticed a cell phone being held over top of the wall of the changing room. She yelled which drew the attention of employees who confronted the suspect when he came out of the adjacent changing room. The suspect denied any wrong doing and said he had to go to work. Employees recognized the suspect as a frequent customer and the victim's husband was able to obtain the license plate of the suspect's vehicle.

Kent County detectives were able to locate the suspect several hours later at his place of employment. The suspect, 42 year old Jeffrey Green of Jenison, has been charged with using a computer to commit a crime, surveilling an unclothed person and eavesdropping.
