On July 8, 2016 the Kent County Sheriff's Department was contacted by the Rockford Public Schools after a video recording device was located which appeared to have video from inside the changing room area of the Rockford Crew House located at 5501 Jupiter Ave. in Plainfield Township.

A couple of videos of females changing their clothing were located on the camera. It was determined the men's rowing head coach, Timothy Vallier, was responsible for taking the videos by hiding the camera in the changing area. Mr. Vallier was arrested and the Kent County Prosecutor's Office has charged him with child sexually abusive activity, using a computer to commit a crime and child sexually abusive material. Mr. Vallier is currently being held at the Kent County Correctional Facility on \$100,000 bond.

The Kent County Sheriff's Department is continuing to investigate this case. Anyone with information is asked to contact the Kent County Sheriff's Department.
