On July 27, 2016 at approximately 4:40 AM the Kent County Sheriff's Department responded to an armed robbery of the Circle K gas station located at 4811 W River Dr. NE in Plainfield Township.

Two suspects, armed with a handgun, entered the store and demanded money from the clerk. The suspects, who had their faces covered, were last seen getting into an unknown make/color vehicle parked nearby and fleeing the area. No shots were fired during the robbery and no one was injured. The suspects got away with an undetermined amount of money.

******UPDATE******

The Kent County Sheriff's Department arrested the 3 suspects who were responsible for the armed robbery at the Circle K gas station. The suspects, 21 year old Gabriel Taylor, 19 year old Emilo Melton and 17 year old Javier Hernandez are all currently being held at the Kent County Jail on \$100,000 bonds and are charged with armed robbery and conspiracy to commit armed robbery. They scheduled to appear in court next on August 15, 2016.
