On Thursday, March 30, 2017, at approximately 9:00 am, the Kent County Sheriff's Office became aware of an embezzlement complaint involving a Caledonia School District employee.

Through the course of the Sheriff's Office investigation, it was determined Anthony Jason Marsiglia, a 38 year old Grand Rapids resident, was responsible for embezzling a substantial amount of technology products from the Caledonia School District.

The Sheriff's Office worked closely along with Caledonia School District Administration and the Kent County Prosecutors and, on Tuesday, April 18, 2017, charges were authorized for one count of Embezzlement \$20,000 - \$50,000.

Marsiglia turned himself in to the 63<sup>rd</sup> District Court on Wednesday, April 19, 2017, and was arraigned on the above mentioned charges.
